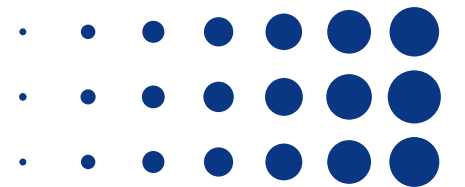

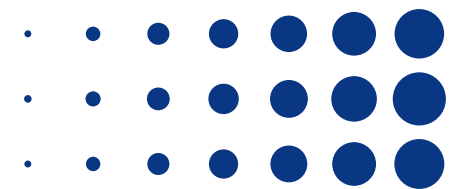




WHY HAVE THEM?

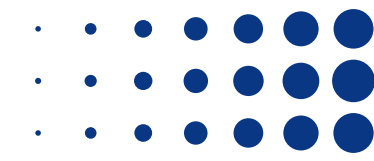

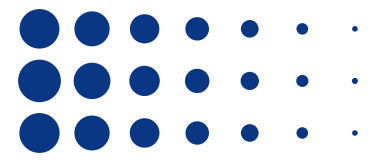


RESPECT

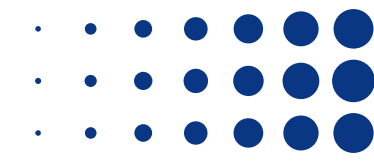


Respect means we think everyone's ideas are important even if they are different to ours!
